

### **Body, Mind & Soul Discussion Workshop**

The June 2015 meeting of the Presbyterian Church in Canada's highest court, the General Assembly, saw the subject of human sexuality and sexual orientation raised as a significant issue and has invited the greater church (Presbyteries, Sessions, congregations) to engage in discussion around the topic and to provide feedback to the working committees of the General Assembly.

The Assembly hopes that 'biblical and theological, honest and open conversation will continue to occur across our church so that we can better understand the Word of God and our brothers and sisters in Christ, and discern together the Holy Spirit at work in our midst.'

To assist in this process, the PCC has produced the 'Body, Mind & Soul - A Study Guide on Human Sexuality' as a starting point for discussion.

Those interested are invited to come and be a part of that discussion over the course of a 2-session study being held on Sat. Mar. 12th (from 10:00 a.m. - 12 noon), and Sat. Mar. 19th (from 9:00 a.m. - 12 noon) with coffee and snacks being provided.
